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THE MICRO BATCH

Since all I've done for the past few months is write books for you to read on here, I thought that this time I would write a tech tips with something useful that won't take you an hour to read.

A lot of times we have a small spot to repair, or an idea that we want to test, but the problem is we don't want to waste a bunch of valuable material to do. That's where the "Micro Batch" comes in handy! Micro batch you say?? Where is that in the manual?? Well, sorry guys, it's not (though it soon will be). Basically, it is a small batch split in half. The numbers are very simple and it can be mixed in a 1 quart container (which is handy in itself). I have given it out a bunch of times over the phone, but here it is for those of you who I haven't....

MICRO BATCH

4 ounces (1/2 cup) = B side
 4 ounces (1/2 cup) = C side
 1 Tablespoon = Color
 10 ounces (1 1/4 cup) = A side

I use this batch all the time, for different things, ranging from testing or repairs, to small applications that don't require much material. It also works great for a texture batch as well. Best part is, it only costs about 7.05 dollars. Much better than wasting a large!! Hope it comes in handy for you (it's been a life saver for me, more than once)!
