Over the past few months I have been contacted by a representative from Simmons Industries about an introductory offer for Superliner Bed-Liner material. I didn't order any of the product simply because the cost is right at \$170. per mixed gallon kit (includes primer).

Last month they called the shop again and offered it to us for just the \$11.99 shipping charge. Just to try it out is what they said. I agreed and ordered the product. Figured what the heck, \$11.99 for a gallon is a deal.

Well I just sprayed the stuff on a roof rack and a grill guard. The first thing I had to do was change to a full face fresh air supplied respirator (something I've never had to do with Scorpion).
